



## SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

In order to receive a scholarship from CSP, a student must first be nominated by the CSP advisor at his/her school.

Criteria for nominations are:

- ❖ Cooperate with CSP advisor in providing all necessary documentation
- ❖ Show motivation and ambition
- ❖ Cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 as a student's seventh semester of high school
- ❖ Minimum ACT score of 17 or SAT score of 820 by February of the student's senior year
- ❖ Filing of the FAFSA no later than February 2008
- ❖ Family income of – see below

After nomination, candidates' files are reviewed for completion of requested documentation.

Decisions are contingent upon available funds. Students will be notified of their status.

Once selected, finalists are then required to schedule an interview during the summer at the Cleveland Scholarship Program office to finalize their award.
