
To many different people, St. Edward High School represents many different things.


To some it represents one of the finest high school athletic programs in the state epitomized in the slogan, "The Big Green Machine."

Most are reminded of the excellent academic program which produces large numbers of scholarship winners each year and prepares even more students for success in furthering their education or entering the job market.














Some equate "St. Edward High School" with Christian Environment where boys become men and learn important lessons about life that cannot always be found in textbooks.


Still others point to the fine accomplishments of student activities such as the band, the play productions, and the publications by which the school is known.

For 1979, the message is that none of these representations alone does justice to the complete St. Edward experience. It takes a combination of all, and much more, to describe what St. Edward High School is really about.


















RALLIES


Intramural Football




Alex Bevan





Concert Band







Although not achieving their ultimate goal of a state championship, the St. Edward Eagle gridders of 1978-79 certainly showed that St. Edward still has a respectable and formidable football team.

After early season victories over Shaw, Padua, and Ignatius, the big event of the young season came on September 30th, the rematch with Cincinnati Moeller. Moeller led 10-0 after three quarters. An Ed's TD and the 2-pointer after made the score 10-8. This was the closest the Eagles got through as the teams exchanged touchdowns in the 4th quarter. Several long bombs fell narrowly incomplete for the Eagles in the final seconds, as Ed's lost 17-14.

This was to be our only loss of the season, though, as the gridders defeated St. Joe's, Walsh Jesuit, Lake Catholic, Toledo Scott, and Akron St. Vincent — St. Mary to close out the season.


The real drama of the season came in the race for the state championship via the computer points race. In the end, St. Ed's came in second in their region, falling short of Berea's point total by a mere 10 points.






On March 10, the St. Edward wrestlers captured their second straight state championship with a record 148½ points. This point total was a new state record, and more than double that of second-place Nordonia.


